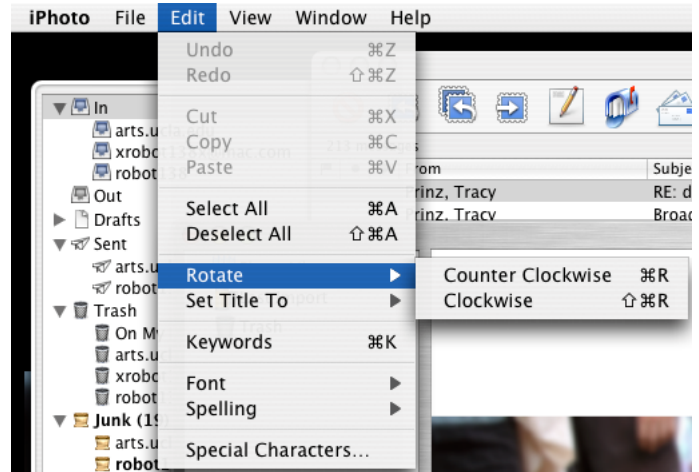
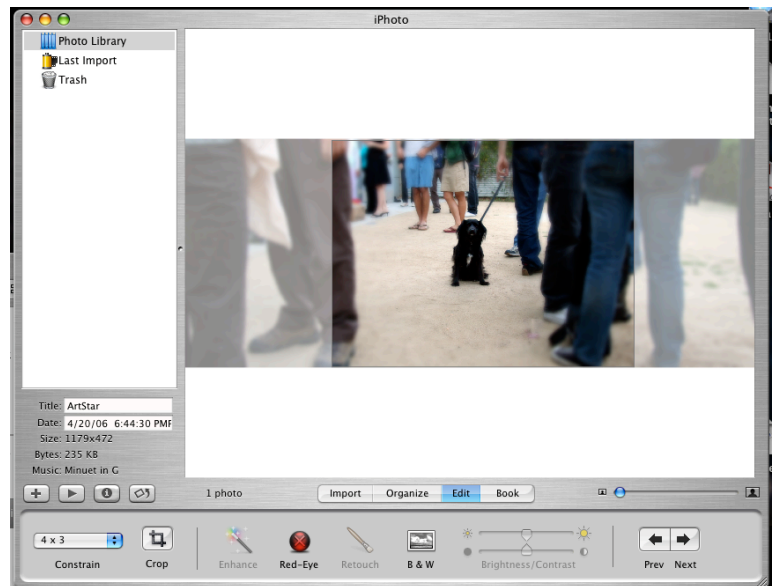


Image Preparation with iPhoto

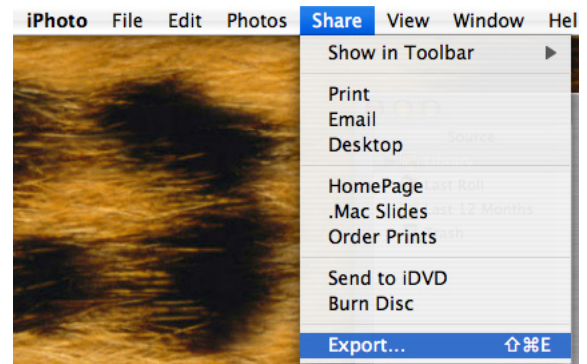
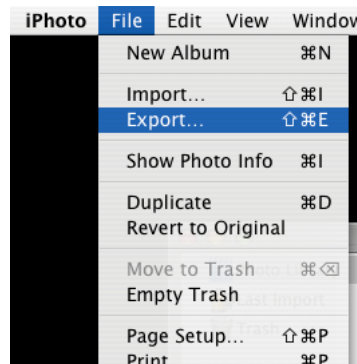
Open your images in iPhoto and rotate them so they are correctly oriented. To rotate an image, go to *Edit > Rotate > Clockwise* or *Edit > Rotate > Counter Clockwise*.



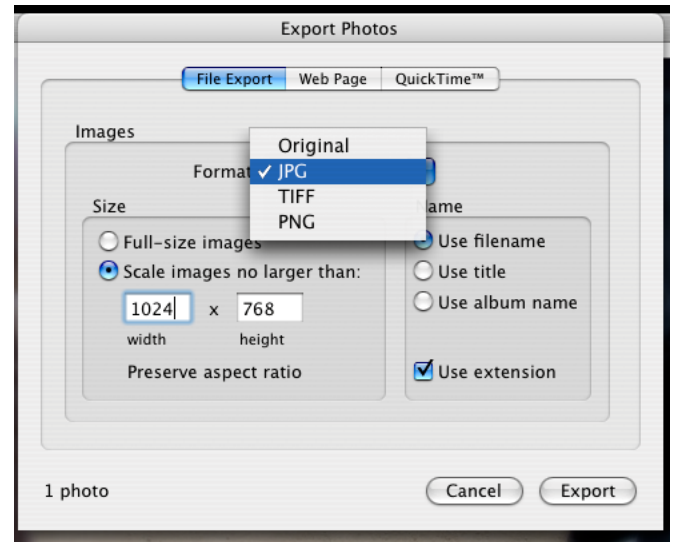
Next, double click to open each image in the Edit view. Crop your image, if needed, by clicking and dragging in the image to draw a rectangle, then clicking on the “Crop” button in the lower left of the window.



With the image cropped, you can now export it in the correct size/format for your portfolio. Still in Edit mode, go to *File > Export*. Some versions of iPhoto move the Export option into *Share > Export*.



In the Export Photos dialog, set the format dropdown to “JPG”, then select the option for “Scale images no larger than” and enter the appropriate size. Refer to the current portfolio guidelines for maximum dimensions.



When finished, click “Export” and follow the prompts to specify where to save your new file(s).
