

Accessing UCLA resources via the VPN system

Many UCLA web resources (JStor, Digital Slide Archive, etc) are only available on campus, or with a remote connection (from home for example) over the UC Virtual Private Network (VPN). To access the VPN, you must install a program supplied by UCLA and run that to connect as needed.

The VPN software is available at <http://www.bol.ucla.edu/services/vpn/>

To install, download the appropriate version for your operating system and follow the configuration instructions provided on the website. Your login information is your Bruin OnLine username and password.

Once connected through the VPN, you will be able to access the larger versions of Digital Slide Archive images (instead of just thumbnails) just as if you were on campus.
