All materials must be submitted by the deadlines; incomplete applications will not be reviewed. The deadlines for receipt of application materials are as follows:

2 official (sealed) transcripts from every school attended after high school; all transcripts must be sent by January 15th

STATEMENT of PURPOSE:
applicants must download forms from on-line application

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:
applicants must download forms from on-line application

SELF-ADDRESSED and STAMPED ENVELOPE:
for return of your portfolio (portfolios of admitted students will be kept on file unless otherwise requested—for applicants who include SASEs, portfolios will be returned summer 2008)

SELF-ADDRESSED and STAMPED POSTCARD:
for confirmation of receipt of portfolio /supplemental materials

DEPARTMENTAL SUPPLEMENT:
including Reference Names and Short Statement about Artwork

PORTFOLIO: All applicants must submit a portfolio of work consisting of a maximum of twenty still images in digital (CD-R) format, with printed back up. Applicants may also submit a DVD, if artwork is in DVD or video format. **Please refer to "Portfolio Guidelines" for specific instructions.**
